

# Award for best oral communications of young researchers

# REGULATION

### **1. CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

The Sociedade Galega para a Promoción da Estatística e da Investigación de Operacións (SGAPEIO) and the Sociedade Portuguesa de Estatística (SPE) award two prizes for the best oral communications among those presented at the III Portuguese-Galician Meeting of Biometry by a young researcher.

This award is sponsored by ProfiJardim and Instituto Nacional de Estatística.

### **2. PARTICIPANTS**

The requirements to apply for the prize are as follows:

2.1. Meet one of the following conditions to be a young researcher:

- Not have reached the age of 35 until June 28, 2018, presenting a copy of the citizen's card or similar document.

- Not hold doctor's degree and be enrolled in a doctoral program during the 2017/18 academic year, presenting a copy of the proof of enrollment.

- Have obtained the first doctoral title after June 28, 2013, presenting a copy of the title.

2.2. Be the first author of the communication.

2.3. Register for the conference and present the oral communication in the session assigned at the conference.

2.4. Papers must be original (they cannot be published before June 28, 2018 in a scientific journal).

2.5. Each young researcher may submit only one application for best oral communication.

### 3. Registration

To apply for one of the prizes for better oral communication among those presented at the III Portuguese-Galician Meeting of Biometry, in addition to complying with the requirements of point 2, you must indicate in the submission form the interest to apply. If you wish to express your interest in applying for the prize after the submission deadline, you may do so by contacting the organization by email until May 31, 2018.

It will be necessary to prove the condition that the author fulfills to be a young investigator of those described in section 2.1.

### 4. Jury and evaluation of communications

The 6 members of the Scientific Committee of the III Portuguese-Galician Meeting of Biometry will be the jury of the awards. Coauthors of the work, supervisors and people who have contractual relations with the candidates cannot be part of the jury.

If members of the Scientific Committee are not sufficient, due to some of the incompatibilities described above, members of the Organizing Committee or other members of SPE and SGAPEIO with suitable CV may be part of the jury.

The jury will evaluate the communications, taking into account the work submitted to the conference, as well as the oral presentation made during the conference. The notification and delivery of the award will take place during the conference dinner.

The decision of the jury is sovereign, and there is no appeal.

### 5. Prize

The first and second prizes, to be awarded to the first authors of each winning oral communication, will receive, respectively, € 300 and € 200 as well as some books. In addition, all authors of the award oral communications will receive a diploma proving the prize.

The notification and delivery of the award will take place during the conference dinner.

### 6. Reservation of Law

SGAPEIO and the SPE reserve the right to modify the conditions of the award whenever justified.

### 7. Acceptance of the competition rules

Participation in the award implies full acceptance of its regulation.

### 8. Confidentiality and intellectual property rights

The content of the works presented, as well as all data and documentation provided will be absolutely confidential and restricted access, therefore it should be analysed by both the organization of the Prize and the Jury.
